

STATISTICS ON IADC MEMBERSHIP AND THE WORLDWIDE RIG FLEET

IADC OFFERS THREE membership classes:

- **CONTRACTOR:** For contract-drilling and well-servicing firms worldwide, whether their operations are on land or offshore;
- **PRODUCER:** Open to all energy-producing companies;
- **ASSOCIATE:** Available to manufacturers, suppliers, consultants, educators, oilfield-service firms and others with a professional or commercial interest in the upstream energy industry.

In 2011, IADC comprises 388 contractors, 56 Producers and 1,050 associates worldwide, for a grand total of 1,494 energy companies.

IADC contractor members operate 4,820 drilling rigs of all types. 4,072 of those are land rigs, with 2,486 capable of drilling to depths of 14,999 ft and 1,586 able to drill beyond 15,000 ft. The IADC fleet includes 593 mobile offshore drilling rigs of all types, including jackups, semisubmersibles, submersibles, drillships and tenders. In addition, IADC contractors operate some 86 platform rigs and 69 inland-water barges. Finally, the IADC fleet also includes 1,521 land, offshore and inland-barge workover units and 68 coiled-tubing rigs.
